The Multicultural Center and International Student Affairs (MCISA) truly appreciates your willingness to participate in the Webster International Friendship Program. This program affords many of our international students an opportunity to learn more about American culture while cultivating friendships with individuals in the community. In order to ensure the safety of students and integrity of the program, the MCISA requests that participating international students agree to the following expectations and responsibilities:

Students agree to:

- Be available to meet or speak with your community friend at least twice each semester.
- Contact the Program coordinator if you can no longer continue participating in the program.
- Contact the Program coordinator if your community friend does not contact you within six weeks.
- Inform the MCISA if there are changes in any of the information contained on your application, (e.g. preferences, address, phone number, etc.)

Students should not:

- Expect that your community friend provide housing.
- Expect your community friend to assist with academic or health problems.
- Ask to borrow money from your community friend.
- Ask your community friend to provide housing for your visitors or family members.
- Ask your community friend questions regarding immigration or visas.

By signing below I acknowledge that I have read and understood the following:

1. The MCISA is not obligated to match me with a community friend.
2. As the MCISA is nonreligious and apolitical, I will not engage in proselytizing my religious or political views to the community friend.
3. The MCISA is not liable for the acts or omissions of the participants (volunteers or internationals) in any service or program that it supports.
